

Getting your NCID Username and Password

1. Each person who creates an NCID must have a valid email address. If you need assistance getting an email address, contact your Child Care Consultant or the NC Division of Child Development and Early Education at 919-527-6335.

2. To get an NCID password, use one of the compatible browsers listed below.

Compatible browsers:

Internet Explorer 8 or greater

Internet Explorer 9 and 10 should have their "Compatibility view" Settings Checked

Firefox 9 or greater

Incompatible Browsers:

Google Chrome

Safari

* Note: Since all computers have different servers, some computers will be able to use different versions successfully and some will not dependent on the security and build of the servers within their system. Therefore, some browsers may be incompatible or hit or miss.

3. In a web browser, such as Internet Explorer, go to North Carolina Identity Management (NCID) website at <https://ncid.nc.gov>.

4. At the bottom of the page, find the blue bar that says, “To register for a new NCID account click here:”. Click “Register!”

7. Create an Individual NCID account by completing all the required fields, including:
- Requested user ID (Suggested user name should include the following: first initial and last name eg. jsmith)
 - Name
 - Email address (This email address should be one that is checked on a regular basis.)
 - Password
 - Enter the CAPTCHA word and/or series of numbers

- Next you will provide answers to a few questions that will verify your identity. You choose the questions you want to answer. If you forget your NCID or your NCID needs to be reset, you will be asked to answer those questions for security purposes.

Notice: Password policy requires that you set up your Challenge Questions

Please note that you will need to remember the answers to these questions in order to reset your password in the future if you forget your password. Please do not store these answers in written form where another person can access them. Please provide answers that are short, easy to remember, and are things that others won't know about you.
